GM group

A 19 year old FIDE-master of Germany Poetsch Hagen stunned his opponents who are all having higher titles than him. He could overcome of his higher rated rivals by his extraordinary ability of hard concentration. Winning the last two rounds he exceeded the IM norm by half a point with 2504 TPR.
