The Gjøvik Sjakklubb 100 years Grandmaster Swiss tournament - December 29 – January 7

A strong and attractive tournament, with at least 10 – 12 Grandmasters, probably more, offering excellent chances for all kind of title norms.

The tournament is open to all players with the titles GM, IM, WGM, WIM, FM or WFM, and to all other players with an official FIDE-ELO of at least 2100 when registering. A number of players rated below 2100 applying before 15.10.2008 will also be allowed to play.

Strong grandmasters **Sergei Tiviakov**, **Vasilios Kotronias**, **Lajos Portisch**, **Kaido Kulaots**, **Kjetil Lie**, **and Nick de Firmian** were the first to make their entry, even before the invitation was made public.

Time limits: 2 hours in 40 moves, 1 hour extra for the next 20 moves, and 30 minutes extra to finish the game (a total of 7 hours).

Players staying at the Thon Hotel Gjøvik for the whole period 29.12 - 07.01 get a discount of 30 Euro on the entry fee. All juniors born 1988 or later get a discount of 15 Euro.

A limited number of GMs will get free hotel and some money to cover travel and food, and a limited number of IMs and WGMs will get parts of their costs covered. Interested titleholders please contact the organizer as soon as possible.

Registration for the tournaments starting December 29 will be from 13.00 to 16.30. **Opening ceremony** at 17.00. **The daily round** usually starts at 12.30. **Prize giving** January 7 at 16.00.

The playing schedule makes it possible to participate also in the rapid tournament 03.01-04.01.

Players informing about it during the registration before round 1 can choose one round to get a bye with $\frac{1}{2}$ points. Players using this option however cannot make title norms, and for last round only a bye will give 0 points.

Also blitz tournament(s), training lectures, and other nice chess program will be prepared.
